## Want to relocate to the UK for work purposes? Need to remain in the UK to make your start-up a success or to make your business thrive?

Then you can take a LanguageCert SELT for Work in the UK exam to prove your skills in English.

### Which exam do I need to take?

Each visa application has a specific English language requirement set by the UK Home Office. Below you can find which LanguageCert SELT exam you will need to take based on the visa type you applying for.

#### Useful tip!

- Sponsors may require a higher level of English than the UKVI requirement for a Work visa. Before you plan your exam, be sure to check which exam type and level is right with your sponsor.
- The table above outlines the language skills and minimum required competence level per visa type. If your language competence is higher than the minimum level required for your visa type, you can choose to take a higher-level exam in the same skills, which will also cover your application requirement.
